

"Grants fur Families" Application Requirements

We thank you for choosing to apply to Bayer's "Grants Fur Families" as a source of support for your important initiative. Before applying, please read the eligibility criteria and requirements carefully below. Please email BayerDonations@bayer.com with any questions.

Grant Eligibility Criteria

The following criteria must be met in order for your organization to be considered for a grant through the "Grants fur Families" program:

- Only organizations that are 501c3 domestic violence shelters (in good standing) with an on-site or planned pet facility are eligible to apply.
- Priority will be given to program plans that demonstrate the importance of the human/animal bond (i.e. visitation rooms, cuddle spaces, pet wellness clinic, etc.)
- Applicants agree that, if awarded, they will create awareness of the R U Safe App, a self-assessment tool and shelter locator.
- Applications must be submitted no later than **December 31, 2018** to be considered.

*Note that grant winners will be announced after the New Year and checks will arrive in early 2019.

Conditions of Support

You will be required to accept to the following conditions of support before you submit your application for consideration:

1. Announcing Support

- Grant winners agree to Bayer using their shelter name and likeness in internal and external communications, including but not limited to print, radio, online, social media
- Support may be reported by the company to the media and other third parties.
- Recipient agrees not to use the name and logo of any Bayer entity in any materials without prior written consent.

2. Expenditure of Funds

- Recipient will use the support only for the purposes outlined in the application.
- Recipient represents it is a charitable organization.
- Recipient is solely responsible for expenditure and management of funds.
- Any unexpended funds shall be returned to the company, or recipient shall use the unexpended funds as directed by the company.
- No funds provided by the company shall be used for any political campaign.
- Grant winners must provide a brief follow-up report on how monies were spent.

3. Anti-Terrorist Compliance

- Organization represents and commits that it will at all times comply with the Anti-Terrorist Financing Guidelines.

4. Reports to the Company

- If the program/project is canceled or delayed, the recipient shall advise the company promptly and in writing.

5. Limit of Commitment, Indemnification

- The company has not made any other commitments to the recipient except as expressed in writing.
- Recipient represents and warrants that it will not and has not provided any benefits to any Bayer entity that would be interpreted as violating the laws and regulations governing charitable contributions, including without limitation, the laws pertaining to self-dealing.
- Recipient is an independent agency, and the company is not responsible for its acts or omissions. Recipient shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless Bayer entities for any claims made and damages awarded against the company and such entities to the extent caused by recipient's negligence and failure to comply with all of the above conditions.
